

Franklyn + Milton Parkette Plant concept – notes

The idea is to have the dry stream bed as the central feature and flank this with low growing groundcovers, such as Kinnickinnick, creeping thymes and woodland strawberry, which form brush strokes of different greens on the “banks” of the stream. These groundcovers swirl around clumps of ornamental grasses – I was thinking blue oat and roemers fescue. We could add in some dull Oregon grape – nice colour with the blue. I was thinking to use native plants as much as possible to compliment the ones already on site and to provide habitat. We could add in some heathers to work in with the ones at the foot of the slope.




